

1. Navigation Bar

The navigation bar allows the user of the page to easily find exactly the information they are looking for. The section can provide a link to any page of the web site and gives the user the ability to quickly find the information they are looking for. Included in the navigation bar on this site is a link to a page with the current contact details of the club (The contact us heading).

2. Club News

This section lets you put headlines of relevant club news right in the middle of the opening page. This then gives access to your members to see what is going on at the club and also gives people new to the club an opportunity to see what is going on at the club.

3. Widgets

A widget is a gadget that you can add to your page to provide useful information to the person visiting the site. In the example case you can see the widget is a UV and weather forecaster. A useful widget like this can add to the appeal and overall look of the website. To find widgets for your webpage do a google search and follow the prompts.

4. Video

A short YouTube clip related to the sport you play or the organisation can also act as a drawcard to the website. It will need to be updated regularly to keep people interested in the site.

5. Major Sponsor Position

Having a website allows you to sell extra advertising space for your sponsors and could enable you to increase your clubs capacity to generate sponsorship dollars.

6. Sponsors Logos

Listing all your sponsors is a great way of improving your relationship with them by giving them more exposure.

7. Results Section

Give your members and other people associated with the league a reason to visit the site by offering access to results of the competition.

8. Upcoming Events Calender

Providing the information of the upcoming events to the members of the club will give you another way of advertising club events and makes the information available 24-7 and from anywhere the members can get access to the internet.
